PURPOSE

The Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination Objective Structured Clinical Examination (OSCE) Station Selection Committee (committee) works collaboratively to select OSCE stations suitable for a Canadian Denturist Multijurisdictional Examination administration.

SCOPE/RESPONSIBILITIES

To select OSCE stations for an examination administration which are mapped to the Canadian Denturist National Competency Profile and selected in accordance with the approved examination blueprint.

AUTHORITY

The stations selected are final.

MEMBERSHIP

The committee is composed of two or three experienced denturist examiners representing engaged regulators. All efforts will be made to represent at least two provinces on this committee.

MEETINGS

Meetings are called two to three months prior to the examination administration.

Present at the meetings are the committee and psychometrician.

REPORTING RELATIONSHIP

Work completed by the committee is reported to the provincial/territorial regulators.
